The major supports students interested in early childhood education, after-school, TK - 12 teaching, youth development and related careers in settings serving children and youth.

The Bachelor of Arts degree in Child & Adolescent Development (CAD) is designed to meet the educational and career needs of students with a variety of interests in child and adolescent development.

SFSU

The Bachelor of Arts degree in Family & Consumer Sciences (FCS) enables students to acquire an understanding of the social, psychological & growth needs of individuals and families.

CAD PATH is designed for early childhood educators who are interested in working 15-40 hrs/week while pursuing their CAD degree with the Early Childhood concentration. Courses are offered on evenings and weekends and includes tutoring, academic assistance, an individualized education plan and case management.

SFSU GRADUATE

The MA Degrees in Education include concentrations in three Departments, Elementary Education, Secondary Education, and Equity, Leadership Studies and Instructional Technologies.
